Contest Rules

1. The art (drawing) must include a message promoting uniting with kindness to take a stand against bullying.
2. The poster **MUST** be completed by the St. Helena Panther student along with his/her parent/guardian & siblings (it’s a family project.)
3. The entry needs to be completed on no larger than an 11 x 24 or 24 x 36 inch paper or poster board. Any art medium is acceptable (pencil, charcoal, paint, markers or crayons).
4. Your **ORIGINAL** work need to be submitted and it **MUST NOT** be offensive and/or display derogatory art or messages.
5. On the back of the poster, print the St. Helena Panther student’s full name, grade, teacher name and contributing family members’ name(s).
6. The posters will be judged by a panel not affiliated with St. Helena Elementary School.

Judging will be based on the following:

- Closeness to the theme
- Neatness
- Originality
- Correct grammatical structure & spelling
