



The Tidewater Community College Outstanding High School Graduate Award Scholarship is granted annually to one senior from each public high school in the cities of Norfolk, Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, Portsmouth and Nansemond River High School. The award is based on academic ability and is awarded on a competitive basis. The award amount will be approximately \$5,000 and will be disbursed in two equal payments at the beginning of the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters. The award is renewable for the next academic year for recipients who maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average and register as a fulltime student (12 credit hours).



TO BE ELIGIBLE, THE STUDENT MUST:

1. Be a 2024 graduating senior from a Norfolk, Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, Portsmouth and Nansemond River high school.
2. Be in good academic standing with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
3. Complete the Tidewater Community College Admissions Application and select your home campus (the city in which your high school is located).
4. Complete and submit the following documents by April 12, 2024:
 - Outstanding High School Graduate Award Scholarship application
 - A copy of high school transcripts (final official transcripts are required for selected recipients following high school graduation)
 - One letter of recommendation from a high school principal, guidance counselor or teacher.
 - Write an essay based on the guidelines in the application.
5. If awarded, the recipient is required to participate in the Tidewater Community College Student Ambassador Program as an outstanding student leader and will represent the college in various capacities.
6. Complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). TCC's School Code is 003712.
