
As a sixth grader, you will follow a block schedule.

Ghent Middle School students arrive to school on time,
READY TO START THE DAY ON A POSITIVE NOTE..

1→ Arrive to school & **be in class no later than 8:15.**

School begins promptly then.

Doors open at 8:00.



2→ Turn your cell phone **off** and place in your backpack.

Remove any hoods or earbuds (put away) as well.



3→ Report **directly** to breakfast in the cafeteria.

Do not go to class to drop off materials.



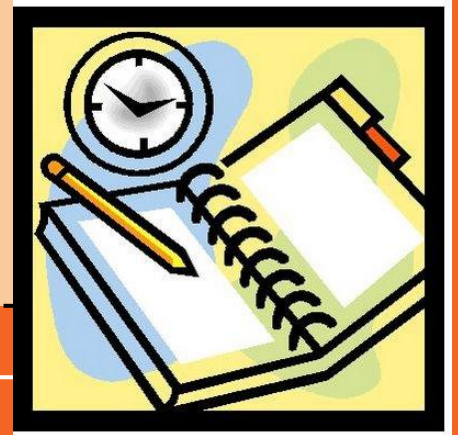
4→ **Go directly to class** with your breakfast.

Avoid roaming the hallways and visiting other classrooms.

Ghent Middle School students arrive to class **READY TO LEARN.**

Students have --

- A backpack with notebooks, folders, and textbooks needed for either an **EVEN** or an **ODD** day
- Their assigned chromebook and charger [plug in to charge before leaving class each block]
- Supplies (pencils, pens, etc.)
- Completed assignments
- A positive attitude!!

Violation Number	Consequence
1	Phone returned at the end of the day
2	Confiscated for 2 school days; parent must pick up

GREEN LIGHT 	RED LIGHT 
1. Private areas and midribs covered in opaque fabric	1. Items with violent images or language, hate speech, profanity, pornography, drugs, or alcohol
2. Shirt/Dress worn with fabric in the front, back, and on the sides under the arms)	2. Any clothing that reveals undergarments including ripped or see-thru clothing (no rips or holes above knees w/o tights)
3. Pants/Shorts/Skirts or the equivalent	3. Hats and hoods in the building; anything that covers the face and ears
4. Shoes-- <u>athletic shoes for PE</u> ; backstraps for safety ("sports mode")	4. Images or language that creates a hostile or intimidating environment
5. Religious headwear	5. Slides, Clogs w/o a strap, Pajamas, Flip flops, Slippers, Swimsuits
	6. Accessories that could be dangerous

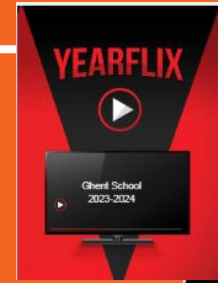

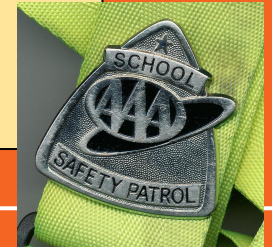

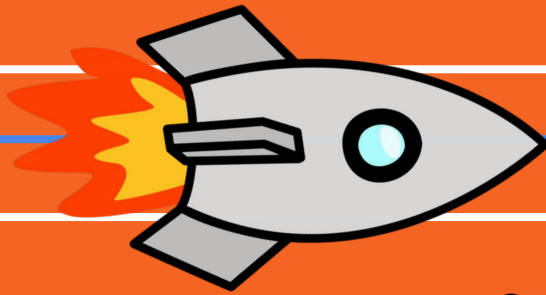
