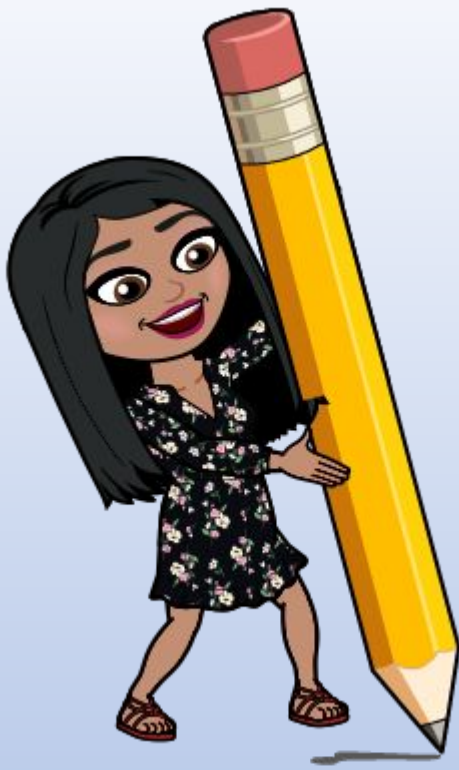

- 1 pack of white index cards

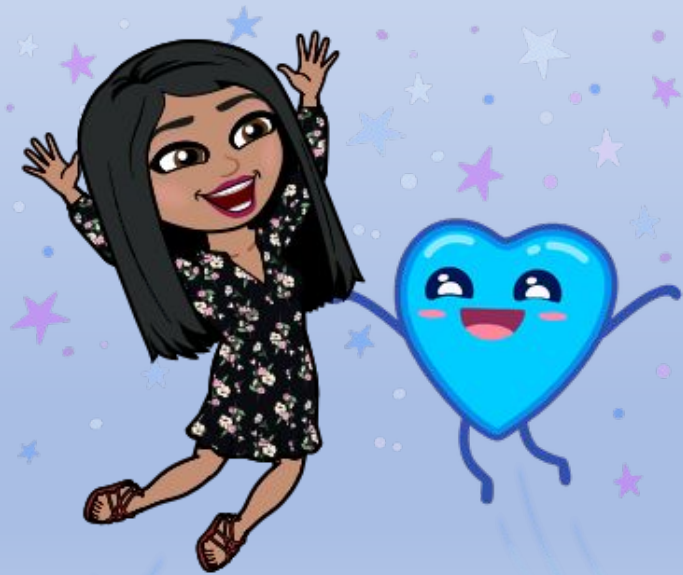

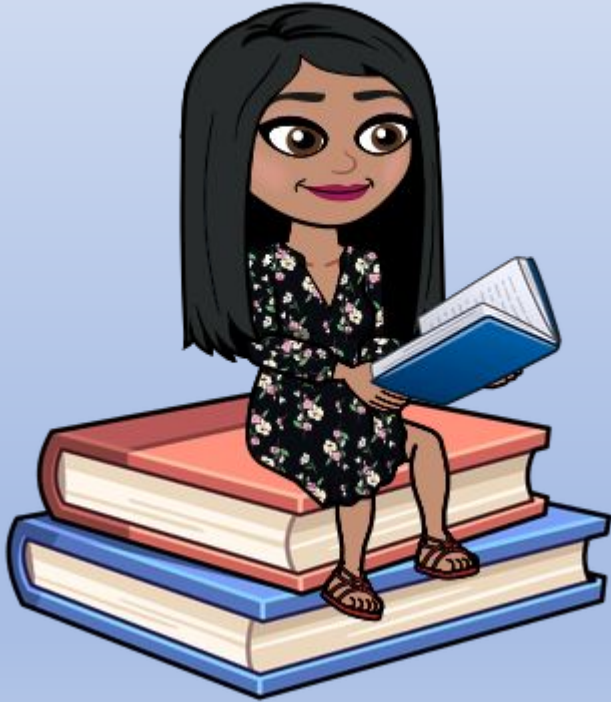

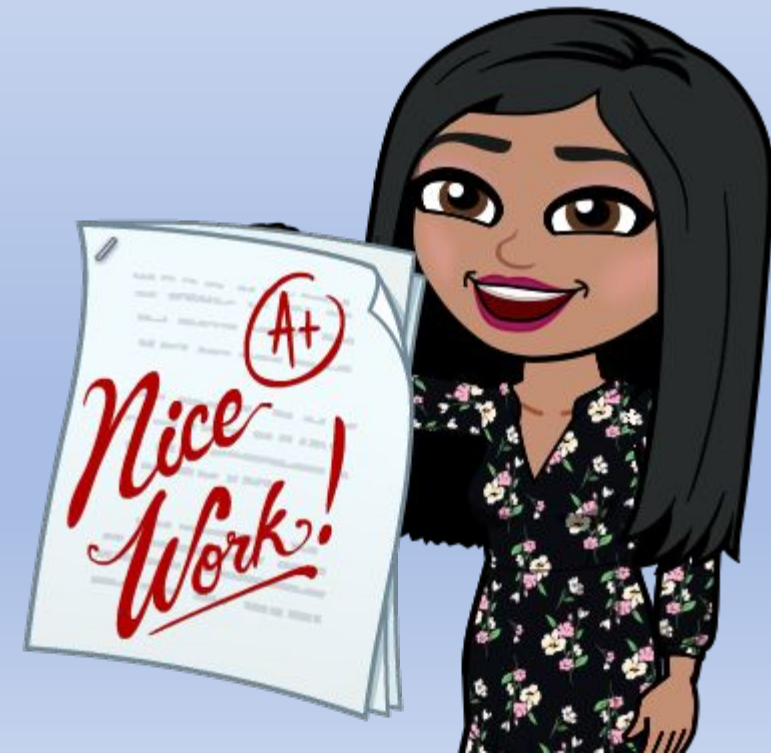
